not be sold on site. Over the weekend of the fair, Hall 7A will be open to children aged 6 and over – entrance is free up to the age of 17 years. No products will be on sale. Consumers will be admitted on the 'Model Railways & Model Construction OPEN DAY' only via the Entrance Ost. A shuttle bus will be available to take visitors there from the Entrance Mitte and from the nearby 'Messe' U-Bahn station.

Full steam ahead for the PressPreview

Hall 7A will be open to trade visitors and press representatives for the full duration of the fair from 1 to 5 February. Additionally, media representatives will have the opportunity to cast an eye over the new products in the model railways and model construction sector on the day before the fair opens. At the PressPreview, which takes place on the morning of 31 January in NCC Ost, the plan is to provide a further shared area for suppliers from this product group.
